CLASS AA LONG JUMP--David Greathouse, Sr., Waukegan (East): "I was very nervous . . . I didn't want anyone to be here but since I won I was glad they all were (spectators). I went to bed real early and didn't have any trouble sleeping. I thought I had a chance . . . Proviso and Thornwood had good jumpers here though. The main thing I thought about was to try to keep my arms moving and to look up at the trees. Our board is a foot wide. . . the one here is only about six inches so I had to really concentrate. Our team has dedicated this season to Jesse Owens so it has been very special.

CLASS A LONG JUMP--Mike Conley, Jr. Luther South: 21-11 "I only took two jumps today because my hip hurt. It was hurt before I came here this weekend. It's really going to hurt in the triple jump so I might not do that event today because I'm ahead anyway. I think I'll just concentrate on the 100. I never touched the board today . . . I was behind it so I didn't do very well. Last year I was fourth in the long jump cause I scratched twice, and I went 24 feet one of those times. I think I like the triple jump better because you can make up for one bad jump with your other two jumps. But in the long jump you only have one chance. Of my state titles, my favorite is the one we won in basketball. It's much harder to win because you have to play nine games but in track just one good jump can make you state champ."

CLASS A 3200-METER RELAY WINNER CATLIN: Tim Koyce, anchor: "He (Kevin Mitchell) gives me the lead and I bring it in. Having a lead going into the final leg is everything in this race. The only two times we were beaten this year was against Mahomet-Seymour. Once it was because he was behind and couldn't catch up and the other time was when he only had a step and could hold off their runner." Kevin Mitchell, third leg: Coming out of the pack and finishing strong on the third leg is what it takes to win. You can be ahead on the first lap, but it's the second one that counts. We came here to win it this year, we came in third last year. Our coach said he's thinking of going to Paris for another job because he wants to coach a championship team, but we talked to him yesterday and he promised us if we'd win he'd stay." @ns leg Brad Sacre: "If Mayerik is behind I try to do as much catching up as I can. Our coach (Don Lashmet) is also the football coach and we've gone to state four years in a row. We'd like to have him back."

CLASS AA 3200-METER RELAY WINNER NAPERVILLE (NORTH): Bill O'Connor: "We knew we'd be there somewhere close to the top . . . we didn't know if we could win though! I felt like I had a good leg." Tony Guerico, "I got a little scared after the first lap . . . I just tried to keep even and give it to Mike close to the front." Mike Stajdohar, "We put it all together today. This was our best race of the year." Mike O'Connor, anchor, ~~W~~ "I knew we had it won. The other guys had a big lead for me so I knew I could just coast in. . . that's a real good feeling."

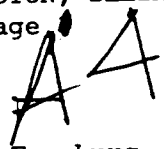
